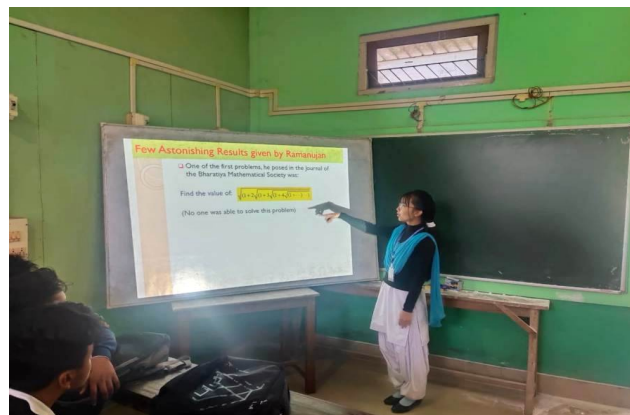

to raise awareness among the younger generation about the importance of mathematics for the development of humanity. Ramanujan was a prodigious Indian mathematician who, despite having no formal training in advanced mathematical concepts, mastered trigonometry at the age of 12 and went on to make great contributions to mathematical concepts such as number theory, infinite series and continued fractions. He also gave solutions to mathematical problems that were considered unsolvable at that time. Miss Kuli has shown some special results of Ramanujan's notebook through a power point presentation.



The special speech delivered by Mr. Abhijit Konch, Assistant professor, Department of Mathematics, Dhemaji College, under the title of "National Mathematics Day" through a power point presentation. This presentation was about the biography and achievements of Srinivasa Ramanujan and his works in the field of mathematics. Mr. Konch has taken care to give students a clear and firm idea about Ramanujan's lifestyle and work ethic. In his deliberation he drew the



attention of students towards the famous Taxi-cab Number 1729. He also showed the photograph of the slate used by Ramanujan. He mentioned the story of Ramanujan's Elbow. His talk also covered how Mathematics has evolved and how it is being applied in all walks of life. Finally he concluded his lecture with a famous quote by Srinivasa

Ramanujan "An equation for me has no meaning unless it expresses a thought of God".
