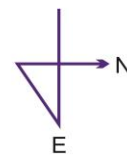

## FOREWORD

Dhemaji College, affiliated with Dibrugarh University, was established on August 1, 1965, as a result of the collective efforts and vision of the people of Dhemaji district, marking an important step in expanding higher education in the north bank of Assam. As the oldest and premier institution in the district, the college today offers education from Higher Secondary to Degree level in Arts and Science streams, along with various career-oriented, vocational, and skill-enhancement courses, and has introduced a 4-Year Integrated B.A. B.Ed. programme from the 2025–26 session. Over nearly six decades, it has built a strong academic reputation while also promoting research and innovation.

The college offers diverse academic and professional programmes such as PGDCA, courses under NIELIT, Infosys Springboard, and SWAYAM NPTEL, along with specialized training in areas like vermicompost and mushroom culture. It also provides Ph.D. supervision and maintains a research laboratory in Electronics approved by Dibrugarh University. The campus is well-equipped with modern infrastructure, including administrative and academic buildings, laboratories, library, sports facilities, and a spacious playground, creating an ideal academic environment. Additional facilities such as a botanical garden, greenhouse, orchid house, seed bank, mushroom hub, and vermicompost unit, further enhance its academic and research ecosystem.

Beyond academics, Dhemaji College actively supports student development through cultural, literary, and sports activities, and through various centers and cells such as CECDC, NCC, NSS, Eco-Club, Women Cell, and Equal Opportunity Cell, along with initiatives like Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. The institution has received significant recognition, including the status of College with Potential for Excellence from the University Grants Commission in 2010, and has maintained quality standards through NAAC accreditation, achieving a B++ grade in 2023 (3rd cycle). It has also been participating in NIRF rankings since 2020–21. In line with modern educational reforms, the college has been implementing the NEP 2020-aligned Four-Year Undergraduate Programme since the academic session 2023–24, continuing its commitment to quality education and holistic development.

## KEY FEATURES OF NEP (2020) FOR UG PROGRAMME

### MULTIPLE ENTRY AND EXITS:

In accordance with NEP (2020) and course structure of Dibrugarh University, the Dhemaji College offers four-year Under-Graduate program in all the subjects, with provision for multiple entries and exits.

**Exit 1:** There is provision for exit after successful completion of 1 year (2 semesters). Students would be provided Under-Graduate Certificate.

**Exit 2:** There is provision for exit after successful completion of 2 years (4 semesters). Students would be provided Under-Graduate Diploma.

**Exit 3:** After successful completion of 3 years (6 semesters), a student would be provided Under-Graduate / Bachelor degree (in the field of study / discipline).

**Change of Major subject:** After 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, a student may opt to change the Major subject within the broad discipline.

**Change of Minor subject:** After 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, a student may opt to change the Minor subject.

**Academic Bank of credit (ABC):** ABC is an academic service mechanism as a digital / virtual / online entity established and managed by the Ministry of Education / University Grants Commission. The students shall have an academic account with the ABC where credits accrued by him/her shall be recorded to facilitate credit recognition, accumulation, transfer and redemption for award of the degree as well as for transfer of institution.

#### Criteria of adopting subjects

1. Science Stream - English and MIL/Alt.Eng compulsory, Maximum 4 subjects from group B, If taken 3 then one subject from Group C are to be taken.
2. Arts Stream- English and MIL/Alt.Eng compulsory, Maximum 3 subjects from Group B, one subject from Group C is compulsory to opt.
3. Class XI Environment Education and In class XII General Studies as 7th paper.

## B. FOUR-YEAR UNDER-GRADUATE PROGRAMME

1. Apart from Major subject, students need to opt for any one subject as Minor from other department.
2. Students need to opt another subject as Elective Course (Multi-disciplinary Generic elective). This course should be other than the course they have studied in Higher Secondary.
3. One Skill Enhancement Course from any discipline is mandatory.
4. Students need to opt for Value Added Course(s) as offered in the respective semester.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

### A. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

#### a. Higher Secondary

The admission process shall start following the declaration of the results by the Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB). The admission for 2026-27 session shall be done through DARPAN portal of the Govt. of Assam ([www.darpan.ahseconline.in](http://www.darpan.ahseconline.in)). The intending candidates are advised to fill up the application form through the portal, and select Dhemaji College, Dhemaji as institution. The admission schedule and the list of selected students shall be notified in the website of the Dhemaji College, Dhemaji ([www.dhemajicollege.in](http://www.dhemajicollege.in)). The candidates may also log on to the DARPAN portal to know about their selection in Dhemaji College.

#### b. Undergraduate Courses (FYUGP)

- The Prospectus (2026-27) shall be available for download at the website of the Dhemaji College, Dhemaji ([www.dhemajicollege.in](http://www.dhemajicollege.in)). The students are to go through the prospectus before applying.
- Applicants must apply through SAMARTH e-Gov Portal <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in> (Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal on SAMARTH). Candidates who apply through SAMARTH Portal will only be considered for admission.
- After filling up of application form and uploading all the relevant documents for admission in the college admission portal, a pdf file will be generated. A print out of the pdf file must be brought / submitted by the applicant during the time of admission.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> & Subsequent Merit Lists will be notified in the website of the SAMARTH. The applicants are advised to check their admission / selection status by logging in to their SAMARTH account.
- Dates of Admission, Fee Structure, etc. shall be notified in the SAMARTH portal as well as the college website ([www.dhemajicollege.in](http://www.dhemajicollege.in)).

#### c. Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

Admission to ITEP with Secondary Stage Specialization shall follow the NCTE guidelines. It will be done through a suitable subject and aptitude test (National Common Entrance Test (NCET)) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).

## B. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED DURING ADMISSION

1. Recent passport sized coloured photographs – 02 copies.
2. Marksheet and certificate of the qualifying examination.
3. Marksheet and certificate of HSLC and HS (for UG courses).
4. Age proof (Birth Certificate / HSLC Admit card)
5. Caste Certificate (if applicable) for candidates selected under reserved categories.

6. Character certificate from the institution last attended.
7. Gap Certificate, for candidates who passed qualifying examination in 2024 or earlier.
8. Domicile certificate (EPIC, AADHAR, PRC, etc. of the applicant or his/her parent(s).
9. Certificate of Co-curricular activities (if applicable)
10. Certificate of Physical disability (for PwD candidates) (if applicable)
11. EWS certificate for candidates belonging to the category (if applicable)
12. Affidavits on Anti-Ragging by student as well as parent / guardian to be submitted during admission.
13. Transfer / Migration Certificate from institute last attended (for applicants other than those who passed from SEBA and AHSEC).

## **Additional documents required for candidates seeking admission under Govt. Fee Waiver Scheme:**

1. A declaration (shall be provided by the college at the time of admission).
2. One photograph of plantation of a sapling.
3. Family income certificate issued by competent authority (i.e. Circle Office). Income should be less than Rupees 4 lakh *per annum*.

*N.B.: The provisions of admission under the Govt. Fee Waiver scheme shall be governed by the extant Govt. guidelines at the time of admission.*

## **C. ELIGIBILITY**

### **Eligibility for Higher secondary course:**

*Candidate should have passed High School Leaving Certificate (Class X) from any recognized board.*

### **Eligibility for B.A. Programme:**

- (i) Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination (Arts/Science/Commerce) with good academic record.
- (ii) For Honours Course, Candidate should possess a good marks in aggregate as well as in the concerned subject in the H.S.(10+2) Final Examination.

### **Eligibility for B.Sc Programme :**

- (i) Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination (Science) with good academic record.
- (ii) For Honours Course, Candidate should possess a good marks in aggregate as well as in the concerned subject in the H.S.(10+2) Final Examination.

### **Eligibility for Post Graduate Diploma in Compute Application (PGDCA):**

*Graduate in any discipline with good academic record.*

### **Eligibility for Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)**

*A Certificate obtained after successfully completing Grade 12 (or equivalent stage of education such as Pre-University, Intermediate, etc.) with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or an equivalent grade from a recognized Board/University.*

## **D. RESERVATION OF SEATS**

- (i) The College follows the policy of reservation of seats for students belonging to S.C./S.T.(P)/S.T.(H)/OBC/ MOBC / EWS as per Government Rules.
- (ii) Few seats are also reserved for the students having outstanding performances in the field of sports, culture, NCC and other co-curricular activities as per Government Rules.
- (iii) Moreover, reservation of seats is also applicable for differently-abled / physically challenged students.

These seats are allotted on the basis of merit-cum-proficiency in the concerned field and candidates seeking admission against reserved quota in sports, culture, NCC and other co-curricular activities have to submit attested copies of certificates regarding their proficiency in the concerned field along with Admission Form.

## E. HOSTEL ADMISSION

Candidates opting for hostel seat shall have to apply through the Dhemaji college website Hostel admission portal ([www.dhemajicollege.in](http://www.dhemajicollege.in)) separately. The allotment of seats to the selected applicants for Hostel Admission will be notified in the college website as well as the notice board of the college. The selected candidates for Hostel accommodation shall have to pay the necessary hostel admission fee within the stipulated period of time as fixed by the College Authority, otherwise Hostel seat will be forfeited.

### Hostel Rules:

1. The students should report to the Superintendent(s) of the Hostel for Hostel Admission.
2. The boarders must maintain good conduct and disciplined life style inside and outside of the Hostel.
3. Boarders must abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Hostel as prescribed by the College Authority, violation of which is subjected to disciplinary action including expulsion from the Hostel and College.
4. The hostel admission will be reserved only for one academic year. The admission in the hostel in each academic year will be based on academic performance-cum-merit basis in Annual/Final / Semester Exams.

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

1. Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building. They are subjected to the Rules and Regulations of the College.
2. The students admitted to the college must abide by all Rules and Regulations as prescribed by the College Authority. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, showing discourtesy to the teachers and the staff members in any form, adopting unfair means during examination, etc. are some of the offences which make students liable for disciplinary actions.
3. Regular attendance in class for all students is compulsory. Students must attend at least 75% of the total classes held, otherwise he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the final examination.
4. Internal examinations like Terminal Examination, Test Examination, Sessional Examination, Seminar, Assignment, etc. are compulsory for all students.
5. Attendance in the seminars/workshops/other academic as well as co-curricular activities organized by the department and college is compulsory for the students.
6. All the powers for maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal and his decision shall be final in all such matters.
7. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college.

## ACCOMODATION

The college provides accommodation facilities to the eligible students of the college. The college has one Girls' Hostel and one Boys' Hostel within the college campus. The hostel seats are allotted on merit basis. Moreover, few seats are reserved for the students belonging from reserved categories. The accommodation facilities in details are as follows:

## COLLEGE UNIFORM

- Wearing College Uniform during the college hours is mandatory. The uniforms for boys' and girls' are as follows:

  - Black Coloured Sweater
    - OR
  - White Salwar Kameez with Sky Blue Dupatta (Kameez should be loose fitting with length up to knee. Churidaars are not allowed).
  - Black Coloured Sweater (JACKET IS NOT ALLOWED)

## REGISTRATION

The newly admitted Higher Secondary and Four Year Degree Course students have to be registered under Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB) and Dibrugarh University (DU) respectively. Registration Form in this regard can be obtained from the Registration Branch of Dhemaji College and the students have to submit the filled in registration form to the Registration Branch of the college within the stipulated period of time as fixed by the College Authority.

## EXAMINATION AND EXAMINATION RULES

1. Terminal / Test Examinations for all students are to be held as mentioned in the Academic Calendar. Moreover, students are required to appear in Sessional Examinations in different subjects conducted by the department concerned.
2. Students must appear in all of these examinations and secure a minimum qualifying mark. Any student who fails to fulfill this condition will not be allowed to appear in the final examination of Board / University.
3. Date of Final Examination of Board/University will be notified by the ASSEB/DU respectively.
4. Promotion to next higher class as well as allowing a student to appear in the final examination conducted by ASSEB/DU are governed by College/ASSEB/DU Rules

## INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

In pursuance of the National Action Plan of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), for performance, evaluation and accreditation and quality upgradation of institutions of higher education, the NAAC proposes that every accredited institution should establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as a post accreditation quality sustenance measure. 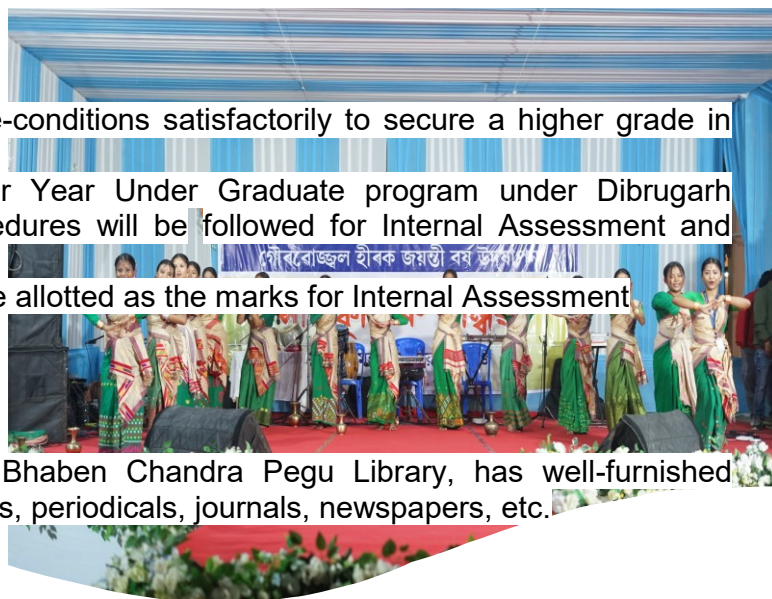
Application to the Principal for transfer certificate will have to be accompanied by clearance certificate from the following offices:

- Moreover, the Semester System in Four Year Under Graduate program under Dibrugarh University, the following norms and procedures will be followed for Internal Assessment and evaluation.  
40% of the total marks of each paper will be allotted as the marks for Internal Assessment

In no case can a student keep a book for more than 15 days from the date of issue. If he/she does not return the book within 15 days, a fine of Rs. 1.00 (one rupee) only per day will be imposed.

## **DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY / LIBRARY, CECDC**

Apart from the Central Library, the College has additional library services through the library CECDC, Dhemaji College. Moreover additional and emergent requirements of the students are also fulfilled by the respective departmental libraries of the college.

## **SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS**

The college offers the facility of free studentships to needy and deserving students as per College Rules in each academic session. The intending students are advised to contact and apply to the Principal in the beginning of the academic session in this regard. Moreover, information is notified in the Notice Board in appropriate time as general information in this connection.

Certificates of proficiency and cash amount are awarded to the students having outstanding performance in games and sports, cultural and other co-curricular activities.

## **GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME**

The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LICI) has launched a Group Insurance Scheme for College Students for bringing under the Insurance coverage at a subsidized rate of premium. The scheme is offered to the college students under 1(one) year renewable Group Term assurance plan. On every annual renewal, the scheme is to be renewed for getting insurance coverage of the students for their subsequent academic year.

Dhemaji College has introduced this scheme under MOU with the LICI, Dhemaji Branch with a insurance covering of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) at the annual rate of premium of Rs. 23/- (Twenty Three) only. The premium is collected at the time of admission. The benefit under the scheme is the insured sum payable to the nominee in case of death of the students during the policy year for which premium is received.

## **STUDENTS' UNION**

The Dhemaji College Students' Union (DCSU) is the general body of the students of the College. Its membership is compulsory for every student of the College. Office bearers of DCSU are elected annually by the students according to the Constitution of DCSU and have to work under the guidance of Prof. in-Charge of respective section of the DCSU.

## **LEGAL AWARENESS CELL/ CLUB**

The college has formed a Legal Awareness Club with active corporation form District Sessions Judges Court and District Legal Services Authority. The aim of the Cell is to provide necessary information to acquire the help from Legal Services of the Govt. as well as to make a close link between the Legal service department of Govt. and the common people from different weaker sections of the society with an aim to contribute towards social peace and development.

The Club has the student members including all the office bearers of DCSU. The Professor-In-Charge, NSS, Dhemaji College is the In-charge of this club.

## **RESEARCH & EXTENSION ACTIVITIES**

The College offers wide scope for Research & Extension Activities. The college has a strong foundation for research and extension activities in different fields. Dhemaji College has already completed several Minor Research Projects and Major Research Projects sponsored by agencies such as UGC, Indian Council of Social Sciences Research, etc. run by the faculty members in different departments.

At present there is one Ph. D. Research Guide in the college under the approval of Dibrugarh University. The Ph. D. Research Guide is Dr. Dipak Kr. Neog in the department of Electronics.

The college conducts extension and other related activities through its different wings.

## **AGRO-SHED, GREEN HOUSE AND SEED BANK**

The college possesses an agro-shed to conserve local flora including medicinal plants. Moreover, the college also has a Green House for rare, endangered and threatened species of plants, including Orchids and Medicinal Plants. The Department of Botany maintains a Mushroom hub and a plantation of food trees of Muga Silk moth.

There is a seed bank in the college named GeneSys-DC which is a germplasm reserve of the seeds of local varieties of rice, other food crops as well as wild species of plants.

## ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

Dhemaji College has produced alumni/ alumnae that have achieved successes both in their public life as well as professionally. The College deeply feels that they are one of the integral parts in overall development process of the College.
